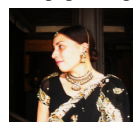

A Message From The Founder

The economic downturn has taken a burdening toll on many of our friends and family here in the U.S. Likewise in Bandipur many of the DHF Families and Children have also been impacted by market shifts from abroad. The most recent cutback to take place has been the amount of power purges Nepali electric companies enforce on the entire country. It was both shocking and frustrating for citizens when television and newspapers reported that these purges would increase from 4 per week to 4 per day. In Bandipur, the villagers receive just 4-5 hours of power per day, mostly in the night



hours. DHF is looking for alternative, portable power sources for its families and general operations including technologies in solar-water heating, portable solar panels, and HHO.
